

Teachers' Day-2026

On September 5, 2026, Teachers' Day was celebrated in STJIT Main Seminar Hall with Prof. Y Vrushabhendrappa, Director, Bapuji Institute of Engineering and Technology, Davanagere and a well-known Educationist who worked as the Vice Principal of STJIT during 1981-1982.

Prof. Y Vrushabhendrappa, extolled the multi-faceted personality of Bharat Ratna Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan whose erudition made him a legendary academic, philosopher and statesman. He recalled the incident when Dr. Radhakrishnan, as the Indian Ambassador to Russia, met the famous Russian revolutionary leader, Joseph Stalin, who spent more than an hour discussing various issues. Prof. Vrushabhendrappa called upon students to read about Dr. Radhakrishnan and inculcate the values of discipline and hard work.

Prof. Parameshwarappa C M, Dean (Academic) and HoD of Computer Science and Engineering, STJIT in his address, impressed upon the students to respect their teachers as teaching is the mother of all other professions that encourages curiosity and unlocks the potential of students.

Dr. Maheshwarappa B, Principal, STJIT emphasized the need for teachers to understand the nobility of teaching and impart quality education to students, irrespective of their gender, caste or status.

Sri. Guthi Jambunath, Director, STJIT detailed the distinction among a teacher, a tutor, a coach, a mentor and a Guru. He wished that the teachers of the present day constantly keep updating their knowledge and skills so that they always remain relevant to the changing needs of their students.
